

Marathon Mates 2020 Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

As part of RNIB Marathon Mates 2020, a prize draw has been organised for a year's supply of KIND® snack bars. Below are the terms and conditions for the draw.

1. The promoter of this prize draw is Royal National Institute of Blind People. A registered charity in England and Wales (226227), Scotland (SC039316) and the Isle of Man (1226). Also operating in Northern Ireland. A company incorporated by Royal Charter. Registered in England and Wales (RC000500). Registered office 105 Judd Street London WC1H 9NE.
2. The prize draw is open to all pairs or groups of participants of Marathon Mates 2020 (one entry per pair or group) aged 18 or over who have created a JustGiving page and who have raised at least £150 with their partner or group by October 31st 2020. Minimum sponsorship amounts reached after this date will not be eligible.
3. RNIB employees, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with the administration of the prize draw are not eligible to enter.
4. The prize draw is free to enter, and no purchase is necessary.
5. The winning entry will be chosen at random by the RNIB performed by a random number generator on November 2nd, 2020.
6. The winning pair or group will receive a year supply of KIND® snack bars to split evenly between them. This will equate to 365 bars total.
7. The prize winner will be notified by email or telephone within seven days of the closing date using the personal details provided on signing up to Marathon Mates.
8. If the winning entrant cannot be contacted so that the prize remains unclaimed for six months following the RNIBs first attempt to notify the prize winner, the prize will be forfeited and the RNIB will exercise its right to award the prize to a runner up.
